William Hogarth (1697–1764): Medicine and Morality – Talk by Mike Davidson

William Hogarth developed the art form “modern moral subject”. These are several series of paintings and engravings that tell cautionary tales through vivid, often humorous depictions of Georgian life.

Hogarth’s London was a city where wealth, disease, poverty, and immorality intertwined. His art captured the medical and social realities of 18th-century urban life with biting satire. This talk looks at Hogarth’s work from both a medical and moral viewpoint.

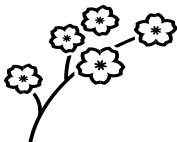


BMS Birthday Scheme
